### **Dog Dayz Dog Daycare Center General Facility Rules**

- The health and safety of our client’s dogs are our main concern.
- A staff member must be within the confines of the dog area at all times whenever dogs are present.
- Staff and volunteers should get to know the dogs. Staff and volunteers must review the pet profile to get insight on the dog’s behavior.
- Feces and urine must be cleaned up quickly to minimize exposure to the other dogs.
- If a staff member or volunteer see anything about a dog that is abnormal—either physically or behaviorally they must report it immediately. Depending upon the severity of the problem, staff may call the owner.
- There should always be fresh drinking water available for the dogs at all times.
- When going through the double gate entry area to let the dog into the main dog area, make sure the one door is securely locked before opening the other door.
- No one is allowed to physically punish a dog at any time, for any reason. The most effective use of punishment will be time-out kennels. Depending on the severity of the dog’s misconduct, they may be left in there for a few minutes or a longer length of time.
- A healthy respect and love for dogs is essential for staff and volunteers. They should have knowledge of dogs and be comfortable around them. It is important that they have a willingness to learn more about dog behavior and the care for dogs.
